

## ***You REALLY need to know this.....***

House Rules prohibit any open flames – including smoking – inside any building on the camp grounds. Please use the butt cans provided outside the cabins.

In decorating the cabins, no staples in the wood please. If you move the furniture in the cabins please return the items and leave the cabin as you found it.

For those wishing to ‘bunk together’, make sure you note clearly on your registration form who you wish to bunk with.

### **Personal Hygiene and Health –**

We will be staying in cabins, with wooden bunks and mattresses. You will need to bring your own linen, including pillows, sheets, blanket, and towels – lots of towels (sometimes they don't dry too good! Drying off with a cold damp towel after a hot shower - - not good).

We have hot and cold running water in the cabins. You'll need to bring your Dopp Kit with all the essentials.

The weather in SE Pennsylvania can change quite rapidly; it can be in the 90's one day and be in the 50's the next. Bring a sweatshirt or something else warm – just in case.

Remember at the end of the summer there are still lots of mosquitoes around. The Dept of Health is advising everyone who is out in a wooded area, especially around dawn and dusk, to cover up and to use insect repellent with at least 25% DEET. West Nile Virus is still a large concern from the pesky flying insects. PLEASE, bring some Deep Woods Off or something else that will keep the mosquitoes away.

The pool is ‘clothes optional’, but on Sunday we are having a lunch at the pool area that is served by (male and female) camp staff; manners would dictate that we show them some respect. (And you don't want to do yourself a mischief next to a spattering grill covered with hamburgers and grease.....)
